**TRAFFIC ANNOUNCEMENT UPDATES FOR MRT CONSTRUCTION WORKS**

**FULL BOUND CLOSURE OF MRR2 & DUKE2 (SUNGAI BULOH & KEPONG-BOUND) AND SLIP ROAD CLOSURE FROM LDP TO JALAN KUALA SELANGOR**

<b>Reason</b>	To facilitate the Segmental Box Girder (SBG) launching over MRR2 and DUKE 2, Jalan Kuala Selangor

**KUALA LUMPUR, 15 MARCH 2018:** MMC Gamuda KVMRT (PDP SSP) Sdn Bhd, the Elevated contractor for MRT Sungai Buloh – Serdang – Putrajaya Line (SSP Line) wishes to announce **major traffic management plan** on MRR2, DUKE2 and LDP, nearby Jalan Kuala Selangor area starting from **17 March 2019 (12:00 AM) to 17 March 2019 (6:00 PM)**. The closures will be implemented in three stages for duration of **18 hours**.

The **first stage** of the traffic management plan (TMP) applies to full bound closure of MRR2 (Sungai Buloh-bound and Kepong-bound) and full bound closure of DUKE2 (Kepong-bound). Both closures are for a stretch of 1.5KM, **from 12:00am to 7:00am** and nearby landmarks for the location is Dewi Sri Mahamariamman Temple and Sekolah Menengah Agama Kuala Lumpur.

The traffic management plan and alternative routes for **first stage** are as follows:

- **Motorists from Sungai Buloh heading to Kepong** will need to use the slip road near Dewi Sri Mahamariamman Temple (underneath MRR2/DUKE2) as indicated by the **BLUE** arrows in Map 1.
- **Motorists from Sungai Buloh wanting to use DUKE2 to Kuala Lumpur** will also be diverted to use the slip road near Dewi Sri Mahamariamman Temple (underneath MRRT2/DUKE2) as indicated by **PURPLE** arrows in Map 1.
- **Motorists from Kepong and Persimpangan Manjalara heading to Sungai Buloh** will be diverted to use Jalan Kuala Selangor (Sungai Buloh-bound) as indicated by the **GREEN** arrows in Map 1.
- **Motorists from LDP heading to Sungai Buloh** will all be diverted into Persiaran Jati, Persiaran Industri and Jalan Utama D/A to exit at Jalan Kuala Selangor (Kepong-bound). Motorists then will need to make a U-Turn at the Prima Damansara ramp to head to Sungai Buloh as indicated by the **MAGENTA** arrows in Map 1. Alternatively to go to Sg. Buloh from LDP, motorists can also use Persiaran Ara as indicated by the **RED** arrows in Map 1.

Meanwhile, the **second stage** of the TMP involves full bound closure of MRR2 (Sungai Buloh-bound and Kepong-bound), full bound closure of DUKE2 (Kepong-bound) and slip road closure from LDP to Jalan Kuala Selangor (Sungai Buloh-bound). The closures are from **7:00am to 12:00pm**.

The traffic management plan and alternative routes for **second stage** are as follows:

- **Motorists from Sungai Buloh heading to Kepong** will need to use the slip road near Dewi Sri Mahamariamman Temple (underneath MRRT2/DUKE2) as indicated by the **BLUE** arrows in Map 1.
- **Motorists from Sungai Buloh wanting to use DUKE2 to Kuala Lumpur** will also be diverted to use the slip road near Dewi Sri Mahamariamman Temple (underneath MRRT2/DUKE2) as indicated by **PURPLE** arrows in Map 1.
- **Motorists from Kepong, LDP and Persimpangan Manjalara heading to Sungai Buloh** will all be diverted into Persiaran Jati, Persiaran Industri and Jalan Utama D/A to exit at Jalan Kuala Selangor (Kepong-bound). Motorists then will need to make a U-Turn at the Prima Damansara ramp to head to Sungai Buloh as indicated by the **MAGENTA** arrows in Map 2. Alternatively to go to Sg. Buloh from LDP, motorists can also use Persiaran Ara as indicated by the **RED** arrows in Map 1.

The **third stage** will start from **12:00pm to 6:00pm** and the TMP for this stage will be similar to **first stage** (please see Map 1 below for more details).

The TMP is being implemented to facilitate the Segmental Box Girder (SBG) launching works for MRT SSP Line where the SBG will be launched over MRR2 and DUKE 2 along Jalan Kuala Selangor. The works will be carried out over three major highways and as safety measure, and in compliance with authority's requirement to ensure there is no live traffic while works are on-going.

MMC Gamuda wishes to assure the public that a lot of efforts have gone into the planning of these closures and all possible measures are in place to minimize impact and inconvenience to road users.

With the TMP, congestion is expected to occur along Jalan Kuala Selangor. We apologies for any inconvenience caused and road users are advised to use alternative routes during this period.

Motorists are advised to follow the traffic signage and police traffic during the road closures. The MRT Project Emergency Response Team will also be deployed to help direct traffic.
